

Wilson Area Habitat for Humanity Housing Program

- We build homes in partnership with people who are unable to secure a conventional mortgage.
- Habitat for Humanity is a non-denominational Christian housing ministry. Partner families and volunteers help build our homes.
- Habitat mortgages are interest free, saving buyers many thousands of dollars.
- The monthly mortgage payments of our partner families go toward helping build more homes for other families in Wilson County.

Qualifications for Home Ownership

Even if you think you may not qualify for Habitat Homeownership, we hope you will come to a Homeowner Information Meeting and consider applying. You are always welcome to call our office at (252) 291-0816 if you have any questions.

Eligibility:

In order to partner with Wilson Area Habitat for Humanity, an applicant must meet four criteria:

- 1. Need for adequate housing
- 2. Ability to pay for a home
- 3. Willingness to partner with Habitat for Humanity
- 4. Live or work in Wilson County for at least 1 year prior to application

1. Need for adequate housing:

In order to partner with Wilson Area Habitat for Humanity, an applicant must currently live in housing that is inadequate.

For example:

- The home is too small for the family.
- There are significant plumbing, electrical, heat/ AC or structural problems.
- Housing is in an unsafe area.
- The cost of housing is disproportionate to the monthly income.

2. Ability to pay for a home:

Homeowners buy their houses so must be able to afford a monthly mortgage payment in the range of \$400 – \$700. Applicants with excessive debt and outstanding judgments or liens are encouraged to resolve those matters before application. Homeowners must also agree to pay a modest down payment toward the purchase of the home. Homeowners must have a steady income history. Income may be from wages or other sources, such as disability or public assistance. Check out the chart below to see if your income is within our guidelines.

3. Willingness to Partner with Habitat for Humanity

Habitat Homeowners enter into a partnership with WAHFH. Family partnership requirements include:

- Sweat equity—construction work, community service, and homeowner education of at least 200 hours (for a 1-adult family) or 250 hours (for a 2-adult family)
- Agree to attend homeowner education workshops

4. Live or work in Wilson County

To qualify for Wilson Area Habitat Homeownership, applicants must have lived or worked in Wilson County for the previous 12 months.

The First Step

To apply, you must attend an Applicant Information Meeting — which is also an excellent opportunity to get answers to all of your questions about WAHFH home ownership. Please complete the Homebuyer Interest Form (other side) and mail to WAHFH.
